We meet every six weeks or so, and in the company of the winemaker and our resident experts, including yours truly, your palate is guided through an extensive range of boutique wines, and those that you fall head over heels in love with, you may subsequently buy at wholesale prices. We provide serious tapas as blotting paper; despite the fact we aim to taste wine we have yet to see the spittoons being troubled at a GWC event. There is an annual membership charge of £30 (which can be for a couple!)

Green apple, typical of the vines grown at an altitude, white flowers, wild honey.

Alsace wines are a sheer joy. This is a prime example with firm structure, lemony fruit, lots of breadth and a mineral backbone.

This classic sherry grape, reborn invented in the cooler climates of Chile. The new favourite of the wine Cognoscenti.

Full-flavoured wine from the southern tip of Puglia.
- 38.CÔTES DU RHÔNE VILLAGES CHUSCLAN ROUGE, Laudun Chusclan 2018** **32.00**
From the best of the 18 Rhone villages this sturdy red bursting with fruit is a real delight.
- 39.DOMAINE MICHEL JUILLOT Mercurey Rouge 2018** **59.00**
Concentrated flavour and linear structure without any hard edges, with fine-grained tannins, red cherry fruit and a hint of earthy minerality.
- 40.BARBERA BRICCOTONDO Fontanafredda 2019** **42.00**
Deep, rustic red with an aromatic, spicy nose. A lovely wine to go with all meaty dishes.
- 41.VIN DE PAYS DE LA PRINCIPAUTÉ D'ORANGE 2018** **42.00**
Domaine de la Janasse
From one of Chateauneuf's top producers – a full bodied red that bears no relation to its 'Vin de Pays' status. Do try it!
- 42.CHÂTEAU LA TUILERIE DES COMBES Lussac St. Emilion 2018** **59.00**
Beautifully developed garnet-red in colour. Shows a very ripe nose of concentrated fruits of the forest and a dense palate reminiscent of black cherries and chocolate with pretty notes of liquorice and eucalyptus. The typically bordelaise structure is flexible, with soft, rounded tannins that bring a balance and add length to the palate which finishes dry and clean.
- 43.BURDESE Planeta 2015** **75.00**
We selected this 100% Cabernet Sauvignon – hence Burdese (Italian for Bordeaux) – on our visit to Planeta.
- 44.CRASTO DOURO SUPERIOR, Quinta do Crasto 2017** **48.00**
On the nose it shows very expressive aromas, displaying vibrant berry fruit notes perfectly combined with subtle hints of fresh spices. Charming on the palate. Berry fruit flavours, great volume, solid structure and velvety tannins. The finish is perfectly balanced, fresh and long.

Absolutely sitting perfectly in its window of opportunity of drinking now.

CHATEAU CHASSE-SPLEEN, MOULIS EN MEDOC 2005 **250.00**

Tasted blind. Dark crimson. Lively mineral note. Very juicy and flirtatious. Fruit and tannin in good balance. Savoury end.

CHATEAU HAUTE SARPE, GRAND CRY ST EMILLION 2005 **180.00**

A gold metal winner at 1867 universal exhibition in Paris, Chateau Haut-Sarpe's praises were actually being sung a century or so before that. Today, the estate is owned by Joseph Janoueix. He bought it in 1930-yet the splendour of the chateau building and gardens is the work of Barn Henri du Foussat who owned Hatue-Sarpe during the latter half of the 19th century.

COTE-ROTIE, MICHEL & STEPHANE OGIER 2005 **190.00**

Deep ruby core, narrow pale ruby/garnet rim. Nose a touch reticent, floral perfume emerging, dark fruit, touch of savoury bacon. Medium/full bodied, red and black berries, bacon, black olive, quite rich and plush but with lovely vibrant acidity and a good length harmonious finish.

RIECINE, LA GIOIA I.G.T. TOSCANA 2010 **240.00**

100% Sangiovese-based Super Tuscan. It's a blend of the best grapes from various vineyard patches with different soil types. A big and powerful wine. Drinking beautifully, it has real scale and depth - an open hearted full fleshy plum richness of Sangiovese.

CHATEAU BOIS DE BOOURSAN, CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE 2006 **180.00**

Dense colouring with garnet edges. Aromas of dusty cherry, black tea, dry leaves, and lemon and orange peel. A little lavender and herb is showing as well. Medium body, good presence with a burst of acidity on the back end, long finish, and flavours of cherry, black tea, orange peel, lemon, and spice.

CHATEAY RIEUSSEC, SAUTERNES 1999 **170.00**

Absolutely phenomenal nose - nectarine, loads of spice and honey and lemon curd. Tremendous length and viscosity, miraculously freshened by crisp acid. A class apart. Magical.

DESSERT WINES

A glass of dessert wine, of which we have considerably increased our selection, is a delicious accompaniment to all puddings, cheeses etc. and also a delightful alternative to port or cognac as a “digestif.” For the more “avant garde” among our customers, a glass of well-chilled Muscat is an excellent aperitif, or accompaniment to terrines and, in particular, foie gras.
